

Travel Information

Arrival by Plane

The nearest airports are Hamburg (70 km), Hanover (120 km), and Bremen (150 km).

All three airports are connected to their respective main railway stations by suburban trains.

From Hamburg Airport, the S-Bahn runs every 10 minutes and takes about 25 minutes to the central station. From Hanover Airport, the S-Bahn runs every 30 minutes and reaches the central station in about 20 minutes.

Travel to Lüneburg

Lüneburg is served by both IC and ICE trains on the Hamburg–Hanover line (note: not all ICE trains stop here). In addition, frequent regional trains (Metronom) connect Hamburg and Hanover with Lüneburg.

From Lüneburg station, you can reach the Leuphana University campus directly with the university bus line 5001 (approx. 14 minutes, no stops). Other regular bus connections to the central campus include:

- Line 5011 (direction Rettmer/Häcklingen – stop Blücherstraße)
- Line 5012 (direction Bockelsberg – stop Universitätsallee)
- Line 5600 (direction Embsen, Schulzentrum – stop Universitätsallee)

Accommodation Options

- Seminaris Hotel – closest hotel to Leuphana University campus (5–10 minutes on foot). Approx. €120 per night, including breakfast.
